- a) Dr. Carvajal reported that enrollment numbers for fall 2019 are still open. Graduate numbers are up about 10% (not 20%). Overall undergrad application/accept numbers are up but we are finding that students are attending multiple Orientations and possibly choosing to attend elsewhere. (whereas in the past if they attended Orientation they enrolled). We still expect our overall numbers to be up some.
- b) Dr. Carvajal was one of four USG presidents to craft the new Strategic Plan. The committee will be soliciting feedback on goals, etc. and VSU will host a regional forum on September 5, 2019 with reps from the USG. More info coming soon.
- c) The Carl Vincent study indicates that VSU is significantly lagging behind like institutions in employee salaries. It will take just over \$4M to bring us to where we need to be. The full report should be available in October 2019.
- d) Dr. Carvajal and his staff brought donuts to share with everyone.
