Thank you for your work in previous years on your department's institutional effectiveness reports. The following information is provided to guide you in the completion of the **2023-24 report and 2024-25 plan**. To aid in this process, the University Assessment Committee and our Institutional Effectiveness Unit will coordinate the collection of necessary information from <u>all</u> administrative and academic units within the university. This documentation contributes toward the evidence of institutional effectiveness **required** for maintaining our SACSCOC accreditation.

Each administrative and academic unit is required to submit an updated Institutional Effectiveness Report (IER) and Plan (IEP) annually.

Reports must include:

- reflective statement on changes made in the prior reporting year
- identification of student learning outcomes or goals being measured
- specific measures/benchmarks of success
- assessments used to measure outcomes/goals
- data results (qualitative and quantitative) collected from assessments
- how assessment results have been applied to make improvements

Plans must include:

- identification of student learning outcomes or goals being measured
- specific measures/benchmarks of success
- assessments used to measure outcomes/goals


