Black conducted over 16 training sessions for faculty and departments on using APL and prepared 17 handouts and guides for faculty which recommend how best to complete certain fields in APL nextED.   - Overall response rate for Fall 2019 was 50%.

- This spring, Academic Affairs will internally advertise a faculty appointment for a Coordinator of General Education. This individual will take a more active role in general education assessment.
- Committee asked questions about recent articles in the Chronicle of Higher Education which
  imply that assessment does not work. Shared how to speak about the value of assessment to
  faculty. M. Black will distribute some handouts on assessment talking-points to UAC members
  after the meeting.
