- Our former recorder, Pat Rozier, is currently working in the CELT (102 Georgia Ave.) until her retirement paperwork is finalized.
- Received the last remaining 2016-17 IER (Admissions Office) on 08/02/2018.
- VSU's Policy Administration transferred from Internal Audits to Institutional Effectiveness (June 21, 2017). In August 2018, released a new system called PolicyTech to help track institutional policies. See www.valdosta.edu/policies
- Watermark acquired LiveText and Digital Measures (Summer 2018).
- Individual assessment consultations with units: Political Science, Music, CELT, Advising, Extended Learning, Adult and Military Programs, and Modern and Classical Languages (P. Moch).
- Offered two working sessions on Preparing the IER and IEP (Aug. 30 and Sept. 5, 2018).
- Attended presentation by USG Executive Vice Chancellor Tristan Denly (Aug. 23, 2018). Video of presentation is posted in Blazeview for campus to see.
- Michael Black was asked to chair the Comprehensive Administrative Review Data Interpretation Subcommittee (Fall 2018).
- A committee is looking into purchasing a new course evaluation system to replace our current SOI Portal (Fall 2018).

- After looking at the three survey instruments available for faculty, administrators, and student affairs professionals, the committee believed those surveys were too extensive for our internal purpose. Instead, it was suggested we make our own survey and distribute using Qualtrics.
- Our Committee has never done a full survey of our campus to check the pulse of our assessment on campus. H. Kanno suggested to repeat the survey in three years so we could measure improvement.
- Members recommended questions which asked the extent of involvement with assessment (active participant, aware but not involved, somewhat involved), time status (full time, part time), and to have the definition of assessment at the top of the survey.
- The business for the October meeting will be to determine the questions for our internal survey which we could distribute in November.
- Michael Black will attend SACSCOC Class of 2021 Reaffirmation Orientation in December 2018
- Continue to promote meaningful assessment practices throughout the institution.
- Review IERs and IEPs.
 - o Memo requesting IERs and IEPs was distributed to campus August 3, 2018.

 - T. Sullivan and M. Holt offered to host a spring 2019 UAC meeting at the library so that committee members can see the renovations for the Academic Support Center.
