RECENTLY SEPARATED MILITARY PERSONNEL

Members of a uniformed military service in the United States who, within 12 months of separation from such service, enroll in an academic program and demonstrate an intent to become domiciled in Georgia. This waiver may also be granted to their spouses and dependent children. This waiver may not be granted for more than one year. An affected student must petition for in-state classification after 12 months and must provide additional documentation according to established procedures at Valdosta State University.
